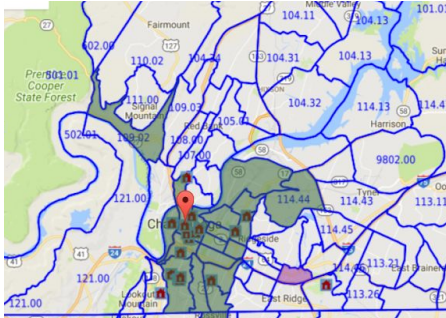

RENEWING CHATTANOOGA GRANT GUIDELINES

The Renewing Chattanooga Grant program is designed to support economic development by incentivizing small businesses and/or renovations in low income census tracts throughout the area. See <https://www.huduser.gov/qct/qctmap.html> census tract confirmation. This staff driven incentive for strategically targeted \$30,000 awards is focused on catalytic blighted-building renovations in communities. **#StrongerNeighborhoods #SaferStreets**

Eligible improvements could include:

- Public parking lot improvements.
- Streetscape improvements that are part of a larger redevelopment strategy.
- Lighting.
- Gateways/signage.
- Design funds for any of the above improvements.
- Site preparation for commercial development including acquisition and clearance (depending on the source of funding, an identified end user may be required).
- Facade improvements.
- Signage and awnings.
- Site project-specific market studies.

The incentive must be presented to the Industrial Development Board for review and approval. After approval, the item must be noticed during a Council meeting.
